COMMUNITY UPDATE

GPG has been working closely with Corangamite Shire Council and Golden Plains Shire Council over the past few months on our Community Benefits Sharing Plans, and we are proud to announce that we are funding several local projects in both councils with some of these projects due to start by the end of the year.

Nathan Micallef the Community Engagement Officer has been meeting with several Local Community Groups, Landowners, Neighbours and Local Residents providing them with progress updates and any information that they require.

ROAD SAFETY

Berrybank Wind Farm has committed to a Traffic Management Plan which has been approved by VicRoads and endorsed by the Department of Environment, Water, Land and Planning and must be adhered to by all GPG and Contractors vehicles.

All Wind Farm related traffic using the roads around the Wind Farm have a speed limit reduction of 80km and during school bus route timetable of 7:45am – 7:55am & 3:50pm – 4:00pm no truck traffic is allowed in this area during these times.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

It has been very exciting to see so much work going on at BBWF site, our construction crews are currently completing the first 10km of access tracks which includes a completed site entrance located on Berrybank-Wallinduc Road.

We have started the first phase of excavations on several the foundations for the Turbines, we are expecting to have the first foundation completed very soon. We have also begun to see the first components arrive for the on-site concrete batching plant.

The site compound is well under construction with an expected move in date at the beginning of June. In the meantime, you can still find GPG representatives at the Berrybank Town Hall.
