Corangamite Shire Berrybank Windfarm Grants

Golden Plains Shire Berrybank Windfarm Grants

Delivered in partnership with GPG, the Berrybank Wind Farm Community Grants Program provides funding opportunities to support local events and projects in Golden Plains Shire.

Applicants will be eligible to apply for grant funding in two categories:

- ✓ Economic Development and Tourism projects and events
- ✓ Community projects and events over \$10,000, with one off and recurring funding available
